### MEMBERSHIP


Thank You to Jan Elpel for sending copies of the newsletter to members requesting it by mail.

#### HORSE & BIKE SAFETY CLINIC

On Sunday, November 23,2014, the GVBCH and the Montana Mountain Bike Alliance put on a safety clinic that demonstrated how horses and mountain bikes can safely share common use trails on public lands. Horses and bikes went through a series of different exercises all designed to help horses and mountain bikes safely interface with each other on mountain trails.

One exercise started with a bike riding tight circles and a horse riding larger circles around the bike and in the opposite direction. The horse circles eventually tightened and the bike circles enlarged until they were riding right next to each other.

Another exercise involved a bike following a horse from far back then finally closing the gap to right behind the horse and eventually coming along side the horse. We also had an exercise where horse and mountain bike met each other face to face. This was all done under controlled conditions in the nicely heated Circle L arena.
